

Proposed addition to NAC Chapter 636 for consideration on October 11

“Mobile optometry” is the act of moving optometric instruments or equipment to one or more locations, other than a fixed optometry office, to conduct eye examinations and provide optometric care for persons and populations with inadequate access to such services. It does not include an optometrist moving between optometric offices that have fixed equipment and instruments, or offering services to persons who do not meet the criteria established in the mobile optometry statutes..
