Required EHR for all healthcare providers by January 1, 2030

Due to the passage of [Assembly Bill 7](#) (AB7) of the 2023 Nevada Legislature, all providers of health care are required (unless otherwise exempted) to implement an interoperable electronic health records (EHR) system by January 1, 2030.

The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) has been appropriated limited funds to award grants to providers of health care to comply with this new requirement. While the technology requirements and framework are still being developed, DHCFP would like to gauge interest and assess needs from providers of health care and medical facilities to determine how to best distribute these funds.
