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## Grant Funding Deadline of March 31, 2025 for mandatory EHR

In follow-up to the Board's 5/23/2024 Newsletter, grant funding is still available for the State of Nevada's mandatory EHR implementation:

The Nevada Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) would like to issue a reminder for the grant funding available under [Assembly Bill 7](#) (AB 7, 2023) for the purpose of awarding grants to health care providers to comply with the requirements of Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 439.589, as amended by Section 1.08 of AB 7, now codified as [NRS 439.589](#).

**AB 7 amended current law by requiring, instead of authorizing, that patient's health care records are created, authenticated, and stored in a computer system by all health care providers.** New law also requires that such a computer system allows patients to access their records electronically and forward them to other people. The purpose of this grant opportunity is to financially assist health care providers and medical facilities to comply with the requirements of [NRS 439.589](#) - implementation of an electronic health record system.

A copy of the approved regulations prescribing the framework for the electronic maintenance, transmittal and exchange of electronic health records, prescriptions, health-related information and electronic signatures and requirements for electronic equivalents of written entries or written approvals in accordance with federal law may be [found here](#) ([R173-24AP.pdf](#) is the approved version) and have been filed with the Secretary of State on 12/19/24. As provided in NRS 233B.070, the regulation becomes effective upon filing.
