MINUTES OF NOTICE OF INTENT TO TAKE ACTION ON REGULATION R066-19(12) December 11, 2024

- Action Item 1. Roll Call, Call to Order.** President Mariah Smith, O.D. opened the live meeting at 1:22p.m.¹
- Public Comment.** President Smith invited public comment. No comments provided.
- Action Item. Notice of Intent to Take Action Upon Regulation R066-19(12).** Director Schneider summarized the workshop meetings of July and August 2024, and the Board's approval at its regular meeting in September 2024 for submission to LCB. Director Schneider educated the Board of a statutorily requisite waiting period of 35 days must occur, then the Board can file with the Secretary of State, then it becomes law approximately ten days later, and is only a temporary regulation because this is an off-year for permanent regulations. As the months towards November 2025 approaches, another open meeting process will start in order to make that temporary regulation permanent, presuming the Board and membership want to keep the regulation as-is. Dr. Smith moved to accept as-is. Dr. Austin seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Action Item.** Dr. Smith moved to adjourn the meeting. Public Member Balecha seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 1:24p.m.
