Optometry Regulations- Stakeholder Meeting for Possible Revisions

On August 17, 2026 Governor Lombardo issued Executive Order 2026-003, directing each board to conduct a comprehensive review of the regulations subject to its enforcement and identify opportunities to streamline, clarify, amend, repeal, or otherwise improve Nevada's regulatory environment.

The Board will discuss NAC 636 during its upcoming October 1, 2026 meeting to gather feedback from regulated industries, businesses, licensees, and other interested stakeholders.
